panel (who it was incorrectly indicated supported these options), had **not been given sufficient information (including financial) to enable them to make an informed decision**

3. We believe that the removal of a greenfield site from the shortlist is wrong and it **does not have our support**
4. 98.7% of 400 respondents to a survey conducted in January 2019 by [HertsValleysHospital.co.uk](https://www.hertsvalleysthospitals.co.uk) agreed that "the Main Hospital for West Herts should be located somewhere in the centre of the area it serves?"
We agree with that.

We therefore urge the CCG, trust and evaluation panel to take the following action:

- 1 Halt the current process and fully re-consider options during the forthcoming purdah period
- 2 Ensure that the affordability, quality, patient experience, access, deliverability, value for money and strategic alignment are corrected to align with the views at the public meeting on the 7th of March and those previously that the plans do not have the public support.
